- 4. Registering only for classes? Proceed to www.northampton.edu/lifelearn to register.

- 5. Need to extend your child's day before, after, and/or in between classes?
  - Register for the Camp Northampton Childcare (Up to 20 hours/week) for each week.

### IF your child has taken a class and HAS THEIR OWN LifeLearn account:

### IF your child DOES NOT HAVE THEIR OWN LifeLearn account:

- 2. Click **Create a new Customer Account** and create an account in *each* child's name you are registering.
- (3.) **Log in** to your child's account.

- Click on the grade group that applies to your child.
   Remember to choose your grade group by the grade your child is entering in the Fall.


