Program Notes:

Dental Hygiene is a fall-start, clinical program. The application opens October 1 annually and must be completed by the deadline outlined online under *Admission Requirements*. This is a selective program, please carefully and regularly review all provided information and requirements. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

Students who wish to take general education requirements towards Dental Hygiene may apply to the General Studies AA.

The program is accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA). Only a day program is available, although two DENH courses do extend into the early evening hours.

For the General Education Elective, students must choose one course (AH or SIT) from the list of approved courses.

How to search for general education electives:

In Workday, use the corresponding **Course Tag** filter to see the available options.

Arts and Humanities = AH

Social Science: Socitieties and Institutions Over Time = SIT

Healthcare Provider CPR and Basic First Aid certifications are required immediately prior to Fall Semester - First Year.

Students must earn grades of "C" or better in all DENH courses to qualify for semester promotion/graduation.
