Fee

Requirements for Enrollment

Some requirements have fees which are the responsibility of the student.

- Must be at least sixteen years of age to enroll.

Must be completed prior to registering:

- Proof of personal health insurance. Insurance must cover the student for the duration of the course.
- Pennsylvania Criminal Background Clearance (PATCH).

Must be completed by the first day of class:

- FBI Criminal Background Clearance.
- Pennsylvania Child Abuse Clearance.
- Uniform: Navy Blue or Black trousers or BDU pants, closed toe shoes or boots. No sneakers or open toe shoes such as flip flops or sandals. Wristwatch with second hand is required.
- Completion of FEMA online training courses IS-100.c and IS-700.b.
- Completion of PA online Hazardous Materials Awareness course.

Accreditation

This course has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as meeting the educational course requirement that an applicant for certification as an Emergency Medical Technician needs to satisfy to be certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as an Emergency Medical Technician. Upon successful completion students are eligible to take the PA/NREMT EMT certification examinations. NCC is a PA Dept. of Health EMS Educational Institute for BLS Training Programs and holds accreditation number 0068109725.
