

Nurse Aide (CNA) Spring - Summer 2024

NCC's Nurse Aide program is an intensive 120 hour course that consists of lecture, skill labs and clinical to prepare participants with the skills needed to take the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program Competency Examination (NNAAP) for placement on the Pennsylvania Nurse Aide Registry. As a CNA, you can work in a long term care facility, hospital or other healthcare setting. Program is ideal for entry into the growing healthcare industry or to satisfy field experience requirements towards an advanced degree. There is no absenteeism allowed for the duration of the course.

Important Information about the Program

Participants must be Pennsylvania residents, at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or GED to enroll. If you reside outside of Pennsylvania, please contact your State Licensing Board about reciprocity.

- NNAAP state certification exam fee of \$135 is not included in the tuition.
- Funding may be available to eligible participants through PA CareerLink®.
- Visit northampton.edu/HealthcareCerts to download the enrollment packet.
- Visit northampton.edu/HealthcareCourses to enroll. Tuition (\$1,499) is due at the time of registration. Course code is NAIDE300.
- Participants must be vaccinated for COVID-19.
- It is recommended that you allow 4-6 weeks to complete the program requirements. Requirement fees (estimated \$150) are the responsibility of the student.
